How To: Deal with Condensation

- Signs of excess humidity: "damp" feeling in the home, staining or discoloration of interior surfaces, warped wood surfaces, or a "musty" smell
- When warm, moist air comes into contact with cooler surfaces (glass) the excess moisture condenses and attracts to the cooler surface
- Ways to reduce condensation: shut off all humidifiers, ventilate regularly, run exhaust fans, open the fireplace damper, install storm windows, vent clothes driers, and ventilate the attic and crawlspace

REMEMBER: Windows DO NOT cause condensation. Windows serve as visible areas for moisture to condense to warn you that there is too much moisture in the air inside your home.

Think of a drinking glass with water in it; after a little bit the outside of the glass will begin to sweat. The glass is not leaking, the water is condensing.

Eastern versus Western Aluminum Windows

Measuring Aluminum Windows Can Be Tricky. Here's a Guide to Help You In That Process.

Eastern Aluminum Window—Window mounts onto outside of the casing. This measurement is the hole size, we will add for the flange.

Western Aluminum Window—Window mounts inside the casing against the blindstop. This measurement is the tip to tip measurement including the flange.

Energy Star® & Stimulus Tax Credit Guidelines

Energy Star® and the Energy Stimulus Tax Credit can get very confusing. Here are some guidelines, so you can be sure you are getting what you think you're getting.

Energy Star® - A window that qualifies for an Energy Star® rating must have a U-Factor of less than or equal to .32 and a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient of greater than or equal to .40.

Energy Stimulus Tax Credit—A window that qualifies for the 30% or up to \$1,500 Tax Credit must have a U-Factor of less than or equal to .30 and a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient of less than or equal to .30.

Our windows with LowE and Argon qualify for Energy Star®, and our windows with TIAC36 LowE and Argon qualify for the Energy Stimulus Tax Credit.
